

School of Media Arts and Studies Transfer Policy

Transfer Application

Because the School of Media Arts and Studies (formerly the School of Telecommunication) sets high academic standards and must limit enrollment, students from other universities or other programs at Ohio University who want to transfer into the school must demonstrate a strong academic performance. To be considered, students must have earned a minimum of 48 credit hours by the end of spring quarter and a cumulative GPA of 3.0. All transfer applications should be delivered to the School of Media Arts and Studies office (RTVC 202) and addressed to the attention of the Associate Director of Undergraduate Studies. The deadline for application is 5 p.m. on the Friday of the fifth week of Spring quarter. Applicants will be notified of approval or rejection no later than June 30. Students accepted for transfer will begin the Media Arts and Studies program the following Fall Quarter. Students seeking transfer may apply only twice.

All students must submit support documents with their application. These include:

- * the transfer application (called “Change of College”), which can be acquired from the College of Communication Office (RTVC 497).
- * a one-page essay that reviews your qualifications for entry into the program, including your academic progress and your professional goals.
- * three letters of recommendation (two from university instructors, one from the professional community).

In order to graduate from the program, transfer students must earn their final 48 hours of credit in the school. All transfer applications should be delivered to the School of Media Arts and Studies office (RTVC 202) to the attention of the Associate Director of Undergraduate Studies.

All external transfers from other universities are handled by the Office of Admissions.
